

## Air Guilin | Operating lease | 03-18 | 2xA320

Chinese carrier Air Guilin has agreed to lease a pair of Airbus A320s from operating lessor AWAS.

The aircraft, part of an order by the Dublin-based lessor with Airbus, will be delivered in 2018. Both aircraft will come equipped with CFM56-5B4/3 PIP engines.

“Air Guilin currently operates Airbus A319 and A320 aircraft and expects to significantly increase their fleet size by the end of 2018,” says AWAS in a statement.

The lessor placed an order for 15 A320-family aircraft with Airbus in 2016. Since the beginning of this year it has announced placements of 10 of those aircraft.

A total of five A320s have been placed with Japan's Vanilla Air for deliveries next year. Another three units have been committed to China's Spring Airlines.
