

# Boeing expects 80 more 7E7 orders soon

Boeing expects to receive orders for 80 of its new 7E7 aircraft in the near future, the company said in an official publication at the China Air Show. At present Boeing has 72 firm orders for the 7E7, 50 from ANA, two from ANZ, and 20 from Primaris Airlines, with letters of intent from 10 more from Blue Panorama and First Choice. The 80 expected orders, if they arrive before the end of the year, would still leave Boeing well short of its original target of 200 orders in 2004.
