

Air France-KLM see 61% revenue jump

Air France-KLM second quarter revenue rose 61% thanks to a strong rise in passenger and cargo revenues. Air France's revenue grew 5.6% to Eu3.36 billion (\$4.36 billion) while KLM's was 8.4% higher at Eu1.78 billion. Overall revenue in the three months to September 30 rose to Eu5.13 billion from Eu.18 billion in the year-earlier quarter. The group saw a 6.5% rise in passenger revenue to Eu3.82 billion.
