

# Air France-KLM seeks to block low-cost terminal

Air France-KLM is planning to fight the planned construction of a terminal for low-cost carrier at Marseille airport.

The airline is also fighting a similar plan at Lyon's Saint-Exupery airport.

The regional French airports want to attract low-cost carriers by providing basic terminals with reduced fees.

Air France has called the move as unfair, as it already uses the costly existing terminals and had no prior negotiation with the airports over cost.
