

Air Algerie takes delivery of one Boeing 737

Air Algerie, the Algerian flag carrier, has taken delivery of one Boeing 737-800. The aircraft delivered on September 29.

The airline will take delivery of two more 737-800s this year, and another four aircraft in 2011. It has taken delivery of 11 Boeing 737-800s to date.

Air Algerie operates a fleet of 36 passenger aircraft: five Airbus A320s, ten ATR 72-500s, and 21 Boeing 737 and 767 family aircraft.
