

Volaris signs \$3.8bn Airbus order

Volaris, Mexico's low-cost carrier, has signed a purchase agreement for 44 Airbus narrowbodies worth about \$3.8 billion at list prices. The order includes 30 Airbus A320neos and 14 A320s.

The aircraft will begin delivering in 2015. Engine options will be announced at a later date.

The order is the largest Airbus aircraft order placed by a Mexican Airline.

In December Volaris took delivery of its fourth A320 from Jackson Square Aviation. The aircraft is part of a sale/leaseback deal for seven A320s. Read more [here](#).
