

Ryanair issues RFP

Low cost carrier Ryanair is seeking financing for eleven 737-800s, according to two sources.

Airfinance Journal understands the airline may be looking for US Ex-Im backing on the aircraft.

As of December 31 2011, Ryanair has firm orders for 27 Boeing 737-800s. The delivery of these aircraft will increase the carrier's fleet size – after leased aircraft have been returned - to 305 aircraft by March 31 2013.
