

American Airlines announces new management team

American Airlines and US Airways Group have named the senior leadership team in charge of the new American Airlines, which will become effective following the expected merger between the two carriers.

Tom Horton, will serve as chairman of the board of the new American Airlines while Doug Parker will serve as CEO and a member of the board of directors.

Derek Kerr will be the carrier's new CFO, responsible for oversight of all financial areas, including financial planning and analysis, corporate finance and treasury functions, purchasing, controller and audit functions and investor relations.

Earlier this week the airline announced that three senior American Airlines executives are set to leave the carrier. These include the president and chief executive of American Eagle, the company's regional airline, Dan Garton and American Airlines' CFO, Isabella Goren. Gary Kennedy, the carrier's general counsel is also leaving the carrier.
