

# Russia plans delivery of 15 SSJ-100s to Indonesia

Russian manufacturer Sukhoi has announced its intention to supply up to 15 Sukhoi Superjet 100 (SSJ-100) aircraft to an Indonesian partner.

During a visit to Jakarta, Russian minister Denis Manturov said the manufacturer is seeking financially stable carriers to partner on the deal, and aims to deliver aircraft in the next three years.

Sukhoi signed an agreement for 12 SSJ-100 aircraft with Indonesian charter carrier Sky Aviation in 2011. The carrier took delivery of three aircraft but was grounded in March due to financial problems, said Manturov.

He added that Sukhoi will reallocate the three SSJ-100s that were previously delivered to Sky Aviation.
