Turkish Airlines has finalised a firm order for 25 Boeing 787-9 with options for five aircraft.

The firm order will allow Turkey's flag carrier to further meet the growing demand at its home airport, Istanbul's third airport, and improve the flying experience for passengers.

Turkish Airlines has continued to expand its fleet of Boeing aircraft. Recently, the airline grew its fleet of 777s with a purchase of three more 777 freighters.

Last week Turkish Airlines signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to acquire 25 A350-900 aircraft plus five options from the European manufacturer.
