

# Transavia Export adds 747 freighter

Belarus' state-owned Transavia Export is to introduce another Boeing 747-400BCF to its fleet.

The Minsk-based cargo carrier received the 1991-vintage aircraft earlier this month.

According to *Airfinance Journal's* Fleet Tracker, the 747-400BCF was previously operated by Air Cargo Germany. The unit is owned by Aircastle.

Transavia Export's fleet include one 747-200F, one 747-300SF, six Iluyshin 76s and an Antonov 12.
