

# Sky Peru completes first fleet phase

Sky Airline Peru has received its fourth and final Airbus A320neo, completing the first phase of its launch.

The new carrier started operations in April this year and currently operates seven domestic destinations from its base in Lima.

Parent Sky Airline received its first A320neo last autumn. The Chilean carrier now operates nine aircraft after receiving two units in June under lease agreements from Alafco and Air Lease.

Sky Peru plans to operate a 15-aircraft fleet by 2022. It plans to become Peru's second-largest airline in the domestic market by 2022, gaining a 15% share of the market and challenging LATAM Peru and Viva Air Peru.
