

Yangon Airways to rebrand as Air Thanlwin

Yangon Airways will be renamed as Air Thanlwin from 1 October, according to Myanmar news website Eleven Media.

Ye Aung, deputy director general of Myanmar's department of civil aviation, says the new name 'Air Thanlwin' may be printed on flight tickets from 1 October, until which date they will sell under the name of Yangon Airways.

Yangon Airways is a subsidiary of Burmese state-owned carrier Myanmar National Airlines.

According to *Airfinance Journal's* Fleet Tracker, Yangon Airways now operates three ATR72s.
