

Aviator Capital seeks new lessees for 777-300ERs

Aviator Capital is in the market with a request for proposals for two Boeing 777-300ER aircraft that will come off their leases with Cathay Pacific Airways in the first quarter of 2021.

The US lessor is open to both sale and lease of the two units.

The two GE90-115BL2-equipped aircraft were manufactured October 2007 and May 2008 and have residual values of between \$59 million and \$64 million.

Originally owned by ILFC and AerCap, Aviator Capital acquired the aircraft in 2018.

Cathay is replacing its oldest 777-300ERs with Airbus A350s and 777Xs scheduled to enter the market from 2021.
