

Canada's Nolinor launches new airline

Nolinor Aviation has unveiled a new carrier after it received authorisation from Canada's Minister of Transport to provide international flights.

Nolinor Aviation, a charter airline based in Mirabel, a suburb of Montreal, Quebec, operates passenger charter and cargo services within Canada and to the USA.

Its subsidiary, called OWG, will focus on southern destinations with a fleet of Boeing 737-400s configured with 158 seats.

Nolinor said it had been quietly investing in the project, which represents "continued expansion into a new market", since 2018.

"The flight portion of your trip should be an integral part of your vacation," said OWG president Marco Prud'homme in a statement. "Our goal is to win the hearts of Quebecers with a new airline whose mission is to get travellers excited again."

According to its website, OWG will launch services on 1 September 2020.
