

Sky Cana expands with ATR72F

Sky Cana has added an ATR72-200F to its fleet as the Dominican Republic-based carrier plans to commence cargo operations in the Caribbean and Central America.

Sky Cana is using the 1997-vintage converted freighter from fellow Dominican Republic carrier Air Century. The carrier is owned by the Logicpaq Cargo company with investors from the Hodelpa hotel group.

In June Sky Cana leased a 2004-vintage Airbus A321 aircraft from Avolon to expand charter services to Miami, Colombia and Cuba from Punta Cana and Santo Domingo. The aircraft followed an A321 lease from Dara Aviation in the final quarter of last year.
