

# Marabu hires interim CEO

Axel Sचेफे has been appointed as interim chief executive officer (CEO) of start-up carrier Marabu Airlines.

Sचेफे has previously worked as group director of fleet management for German carrier Condor Airlines and at Thomas Cook Airlines as group director of fleet management.

Investment fund Attestor founded Marabu late last year. The company launched under its own operating certificate this summer using Airbus A320neo equipment, with ticket sales handled by partner airline Condor.

According to the original fleet plan, Nordic Aviation Group would initially provide operational support services under Nordica's AOC together with wetlease services utilising three A320neo aircraft and crews.

In December, Airfinance Journal broke the news that [ACG was also transferring used first-generation A320neos to Condor's Estonia-based offshoot Marabu](#).

These four A320neo aircraft came off lease after their initial six-year leases with India's Indigo Airlines and have been delivered to Marabu in the past four months, according to Airfinance Journal's Fleet Tracker.
