

Exclusive: Societe Generale promotes aviation chief head

Societe Generale Corporate and Investment Banking (SGCIB) has promoted aviation global head Yann Sonnallier to the position of deputy head of transportation and leasing.

Sonnallier will keep his existing global responsibilities over aviation financings and advisory but will add supervision responsibilities over global transportation (maritime and land transportation) and leasing under his new position.

In 2012 he was named adviser to the CEO of Corporate & Investment Banking.
